

## How to Register a Student or Sponsor

Step 1: Visit <u>www.wvsnazarene.org</u>

Step 2: Click on News & Events

Step 3: Click on WVS NYC 2023

Step 4: Click on the button that says "Register for Nazarene Youth Conference 2023"

**Step 5:** Submit your online registration. You will receive a confirmation email after submitting the online registration.

**Step 6:** Submit a check for \$200.00 to the District NYC Coordinator. <u>*Please make the check*</u> <u>payable to WVS NYI. (Allan Jones - 243 Dutch Road – Charleston, WV 25302)</u>

Participant registration is **not complete until you've completed the online registration**, and your deposit has been submitted.

#### Registration & deposit of \$200 are due by September 15, 2022.

Monthly payments of \$200 will be due from September 15, 2022 to May 15, 2023. <u>*Please*</u> <u>make the check payable to WVS NYI. (Allan Jones - 243 Dutch Road – Charleston, WV 25302)</u>

Participants can pay ahead of schedule.

## **Important Registration Notes**

- You'll be asked for a mobile number and/or email address as you begin the registration process. You will need to use a mobile number and/or email address that you currently have access to so you can retrieve the six-digit login code.
- If you have other participants to register from your family, log-out in the upper right corner, and follow the process from the beginning. If you reach a screen that says "Hello!", be sure to click the NOT YOU button and create a new profile for the new participant. The same mobile number and email address can be used, but the profile name needs to be the participant name.
- If you leave any of the required fields blank, the system won't let you move on... and it will clear the form so you will have to start over.
- If at any time during the registration process, you find yourself at a white screen with a menu at the top, close the window and click on the registration link again. It should take you to where you left off and you can move forward in the registration process.
- Remember, unless prompted for Parent/Guardian Name or Email, all profile information entered is for the participant.



## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### Who is eligible to attend NYC '23?

A student is eligible to participate if they graduate from high school between 2023 and 2027. The age cut-off is 19 years old.

#### How much will airfare cost?

Airfare costs will be determined near the end of 2022 or beginning of 2023. A good ballpark figure would be \$600 per round trip flight, but please keep in mind that this is only an estimate. We believe it may be less.

#### How does the registration process work?

The registration process is done completely online. Once you've completed the online registration, you'll need to submit your \$200.00 deposit. *Please make the check payable to WVS NYI. (Allan Jones - 243 Dutch Road – Charleston, WV 25302)* 

### What about adult sponsors?

NYC requires that we provide at least one adult sponsor for every eight students. Sponsors must register online and pay on the same schedule as the participants. WVS NYI Council will only recognize NYI Presidents, Youth Pastors, Senior Pastors or their spouse as sponsors. There are NO discounts for sponsor registration. It is recommended that the local church assist with fees associated with this trip. Sponsors must be 23 years old by July 5, 2023. Every adult attending NYC must complete two requirements prior to the event: Nazarene Safe (or equal) training and a qualifying background check that utilizes local, state, and national registries.

#### What is the Field Event?

The East Central Field is comprised of districts found in West Virginia, Ohio and Kentucky. The West Virginia South (WVS) is one of those districts. To kick off NYC '23, each field gets together for a fun-filled field event.

### Why Tampa, Florida?

USA/Canada NYI (Nazarene Youth International) has a set list of criteria for NYC host cities. There must be a convention hall and arena that can host 7,000+ participants. Additionally, there must be enough hotel rooms within a certain radius that can house all of the participants. NYC is committed to partnering with the host city to leave a lasting impact through MWO (Ministry with Others) projects. As you can imagine, not many organizations seek to host a conference in Tampa in July because of the temperatures. The City of Tampa is anticipating our time in their city, and they've gone out of their way to accommodate many of our requests.

### Where will participants stay during NYC '23?

Our specific hotel location will be announced March 2023. District leadership will do their best to honor roommate requests. Each room will come equipped with two large beds, and each room will house four students.

#### Are there any hidden costs?

No. The cost of \$2000 will cover all meals, housing, transportation in Florida, and excursions (each local church is responsible for transportation to central meeting location on the day of departure. Location yet to be determined). It also covers district shirts, as well as the group photo poster and other event materials on site. Students are encouraged to bring extra money for miscellaneous snack purchases, in addition to any souvenirs they may want to purchase throughout the trip.

### How will payments be submitted? Can we pay online?

All participant payments are to be submitted to the WVS South District NYC Coordinator each month. We cannot accept online payments of any kind due to the revenue loss associated with online fees. <u>Please make the check payable to WVS NYI. (Allan Jones -</u> <u>243 Dutch Road – Charleston, WV 25302)</u>

### Is August 30, 2022 really the deadline to get registered?

No. However, to assist families with the overall cost of NYC '23, we think it's a good idea to spread the payments out over a longer period of time. Registering by August 30, 2022 will make completing the payments more manageable. At the end of this packet, you will find a chart showing the deposit payment and subsequent payments you will need to make. *This will vary, depending on when you actually register and begin the process*. You will notice that the later you register, the larger your first payment will be. This is necessary to reserve your place and assure that you are on track at crucial times during the process. **The last day of the Early Bird registration is October 15, 2022. Beginning October 16, 2022, the registration fee will increase to \$525.00.** The last official day to register is January 01, 2023. Refunds of any kind or amount will not be possible after plane tickets have been purchased.

### What about a refund for unforeseen circumstances or emergencies?

In order to enhance confidence toward registration and protect individuals and families from financial losses due to unforeseen circumstances, we have secured insurance coverage to mediate a wide variety of known risks and potential loss. All registered participants are covered by trip cancellation and interruption insurance due to verifiable triggers, such as medical related issues, travel restrictions, state/CDC advisories, family emergency, etc. Through an individual claims process after the event, there will be an opportunity to recoup non-refundable portions of event related expenses.
